

SGA Bill No. 10-02-F

A resolution to allow the author of SGA legislation to attend Faculty Senate Meetings for the purpose of presenting legislation passed by SGA and for reporting the status of such legislation back to SGA.

Whereas: All legislation passed by the Student Government Association must be passed by the faculty Senate in order for said legislation to be implemented,

Whereas: Only the author of a piece of legislation may make necessary changes or amendments,

Whereas: Communication between the Faculty Senate and the Student Government Association needs improvement, the author of legislation passed by the Student Government Association which is to be presented to the Faculty Senate should be present at the appropriate Faculty Senate meeting.


THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 65TH SGA CONGRESS THAT:

Section 1: Upon passage, the author of any legislation passed by SGA should accompany said legislation to Faculty Senate meetings.

Section 2: In the event that the author of approved legislation is unable to attend the Faculty Senate meetings, a member or members of the SGA Faculty/Administration Committee would represent the absent member.

Section 3: After each Faculty Senate meeting which involves debate of SGA legislation, the Senator who attended the meeting will report the status of the legislation to SGA Senate.
