

SGA Bill 33-03-F

A bill to require all legislation to be submitted to the Executive Vice President no later than one calendar week before the Senate session in which it will be presented. Upon submission, legislation will be posted on the MTSU server for reading and review.

Whereas: The purpose of the Student Government Association is to be a voice for the students,

Whereas: The Senate is elected to speak on behalf of the students,

Whereas: Opportunities should be made available to hear the voice of the student body,

Whereas: Student accounts are readily accessible,

Therefore, let it be resolved by the 66th Congress that:

Section 1: Legislation is required to be submitted one calendar week before the Senate session in which it will be presented.


Section 2: The Executive Vice President/ Speaker of the Senate shall submit the legislation for posting within three calendar days.


Section 3: Students can comment on legislation through, but not limited to, the outlets of email or by calling the SGA office by three calendar days before the Senate session in which the legislation will be presented.

Section 4: Student comments may or may not affect the passage of said legislation, but are intended to assist the author(s) in preparing the legislation for presentation to the Senate.

Section 5: Upon passage, a bill affecting Internal Affairs be excluded.
