A Resolution to have President McPhee, Dr. Gloria Bonner, Dean of the College of Education and Behavioral Sciences, and Dr. Papini, Psychology Department Chair, review the decision of the promotion and tenure committee in the case of Dr. Kramer.

Whereas: MTSU is a teaching university, and

Whereas: Student evaluations of Dr. Kramer rate him an average 8.7 out of 10, with "one of the best teachers ever" being 10 and "one of the worst ever" being a 1, and

Whereas: In the fall 2004, Dr. Kramer was the professor with the single most research hours in his department with a total of 967.7 hours logged, and

Whereas: Over 100 students protested outside of Dr. Bonner's office on Thursday March 24, and


Whereas: The protests of the students and the MTSU community about the Dr. Kramer issue have been ignored by the administration, and


Whereas: The promotion and tenure committee have not demonstrated objective criteria or consistency in their evaluation of Dr. Kramer.
