Whereas: The role of the Student Government Association is to serve as the voice of the students



Section 1: If any changes are being considered to on-campus dining venues, SGA will be informed and provided with details regarding the change, including location and options being considered.


Section 2: Upon receiving notice of said changes, the SGA Student Life Committee will prepare a survey based on the details received.

Section 3: The survey will be open for a minimum of one week, with the results being compiled into a formal report by the SGA Vice President of Campus Relations.


